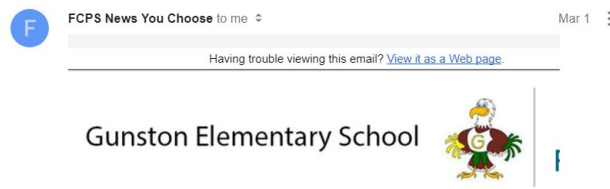

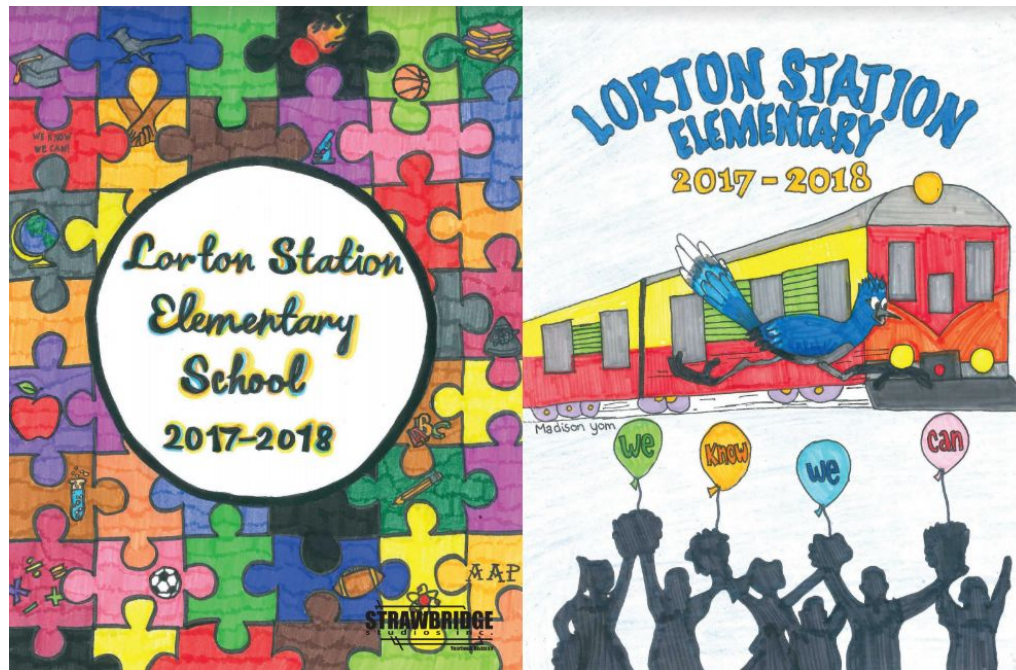
Fundraising (7:45 - 7:50)
